Please pray as well for the Bible study with the family from Granátula. We started again on 22 September. They continue to show interest in growing in their faith. Pray that they will also be able to attend Sunday services. John's health has improved, but spiritually he is further away. Once he felt better he stopped taking part in the Bible study. Please pray for him.

Noemí is going to resume the online meeting that she had with the ladies from our congregation and contacts from the town, as well as sisters from Santa Cruz de Mudela and Valdepeñas. She also wants to suggest to Tere, the sister of our deacon Julián, the possibility of starting a Bible study with her. Pray that Tere will want to do that.

SANTA CRUZ DE MUDELA Sergio, Chani & Jennifer

Dearly beloved in the Lord,

We are very thankful to the Lord for His faithfulness shown to us each day, although we do not deserve it. We trust in His word which promises us that, though we are faithless, He remains faithful.

We have seen how the Lord has been gracious to our country because, thanks to God, the pandemic situation has improved considerably in Spain, the vaccination programme is proving effective and infections are fewer. There were no new infections in the town in the last three weeks, and the Lord in His mercy has continued to protect the church family.

We have a heavy heart for the situation on La Palma in the Canary Islands (our homeland), where the volcanic eruption is unstoppable. 6000 people have already been evacuated, with the loss of hundreds of homes, schools and farms.

Seeing these events, we cannot help but think of the words in Isaiah 24:1-6. Both the pandemic and the destruction caused by the forces of nature remind us that the Lord's return is approaching; His judgments are coming on this world that has turned its back on Him more and more. May the Lord have mercy and may we as his people stand firm and faithful!

PRAY FOR THE CHURCH

We are now holding meetings as normal, although masks must still be worn inside the building. At the end of September we resumed Bible studies with a family in Almuradiel, a town about 15 km from Santa Cruz. These had to stop for a while because Cristóbal relapsed in his drug addiction in July and had to go to Jaén for treatment. Pray for them: Cristóbal is better again but he is very weak and his problems drive him to drugs; his wife Rosario suffers a lot, feeling helpless when her husband has a relapse time and again; their children, 13-year-old Diego and 3-year-old Samara are innocent victims in this situation.

With Fernando, we have finished the fourth study in the series "New Life in Christ", and we are starting the next one. Fernando is doing very well and is quite keen to continue learning. His father Eugenio continues to show interest and asks many questions. Please continue to pray for them that the Lord by His Spirit would open their hearts for salvation. Eugenio had cataract surgery on 22 September.

We have started the new session of Sunday school with the church children. There are only a few. Please pray that the children of Cristóbal and Rosario can be added to their number. Let's pray that the Lord would work in the hearts of our children and they will one day come to know Him as Lord and Saviour.

We also hope, God-willing, to resume the children's Bible club soon. Ask the Lord for this and for Chani and Sara, and that He will graciously reach each child's heart for Christ.

Please keep praying for our elderly church members, for health and renewed enthusiasm to carry on attending services.

Please pray for Felipe who has recently moved back into a care home and his daughter Sara that the Lord would touch her heart.

Please pray for Paquita and her husband Antonio who is gradually recovering from cancer; physically, he is doing quite well but his heart is still far from God.

We thank God that Juana is doing better. She spent a week with her daughter and family in Tarragona; it helped a lot to improve her mood and she came back very happy having enjoyed the time there with the family. Continue to pray for her, for her health and that she will find strength and comfort in the Lord.

Please pray for Sofi and Ramón. They are getting on okay but his mobility is gradually getting worse, which means Sofi has a lot to

do and needs strength as she has to attend to all his needs. This also means that she is rarely able to leave the house.

Thanks to the Lord, Germán is still working and he is keen to continue the SEFOVAN training in the Monescillo centre. Please pray for Eva as well, for health and encouragement.

Pray too for Sara, David and their children. We are asking that David would wake up to the reality of his life, feel his need for salvation and confess the Lord Jesus Christ as his Saviour.

PRAY FOR THE FAMILY

For us as a couple, we need much wisdom to know how to reach the hearts of the people living in this town. Idolatry plays a significant part and they take refuge in it so that they do not feel the need to seek the true and living God. We need the Lord to guide us to individuals who are seeking Him sincerely and to open doors to preach the gospel to them.

Chani still has her health issues. She is waiting for an MRI scan and to be seen by a gastroenterologist. Pray that she will feel well and have strength and courage for the work.

Jenni has started her second year in high school and is adjusting well, thanks to the Lord. We are grateful to God for the school counsellor this year – she has known Jenni since she was seven and is the person who discovered that Jenni had a language disorder. This is a great advantage as she does not have to start from scratch when working with Jennifer. Also, the teacher-tutor for this year has worked for many years with children who have language problems. We are pleased and give thanks to God.

Please pray also for our older children and our grandchildren that the Lord would keep protecting them and helping them in the midst of the problems they are going through.

Please continue to pray for us in our pastoral work, that the Lord would continue to give us the strength, encouragement, wisdom and vision we need to work in the Lord's church.
