#### **OUR UKRAINIAN SISTERS**

Tatiana and her five children, together with her sister Mariana, have returned to Ukraine after living in Moral for four months. Tatiana's husband is in the army and has to go to the front line so she wanted to see him before he goes to war. The last I heard is that they and the children are well; her husband stayed at home for a month due to a health problem (inflamed knee), but is now back in the army. Please pray for this family that God would guard them and protect her husband in the war.

Mariana is with her parents, helping them with home tasks and farm work. She is also teaching English online. She is very keen to serve the Lord and told us that her time with us had been a great blessing for her life. While in Ukraine, she was reunited with her previous congregation and she felt that God was guiding her to serve Him somewhere. On 25 September she sent me a WhatsApp message saying that, after much prayer, she felt the Lord wanted her to return to Spain to help us in the work here in Moral, so she will return here on 5 October and will be working with us in the church and will also continue the online English classes with her students. Please pray for her that this decision

was in accordance with the Lord's will, that she can work here giving English classes, and also that she can learn Spanish quickly and be able to attend the SEFOVAN Bible training here. Please pray for all this.



#### **DISCIPLING**

Encarna continues to disciple Marianny, our sister from Venezuela. We see fruit from this work, as Marianny has asked to be baptised and is firmly believing in the Lord.

Noemí meets with Mari Nieves and Tere. They are both growing well and enjoying the Bible studies, and they both attend Sunday services – Tere less frequently. Mari Nieves attends every Sunday and wants to restore her relationship with the church and become a member in fellowship with us. After 19 years away from the church, the Lord has worked in her heart so she is returning to be part of God's family in Moral. We thank the Lord for this blessing. Noemí has also started discipling Verónica, a new sister attending church with her family (see below).

#### **FAMILIES TO PRAY FOR**



Marianny has asked to be baptised. She has been living in Moral for several months with her husband Roberto (not yet a believer) and her two lovely daughters, Isabela and Victoria. several years; when I used to attend the Herrar de La Mancha prison, he was there due to driving without a licence. A few months ago, he called me to say he would like to live in Moral and be able to attend our church; both he and his wife wanted the children to grow up attending our church. So we got to work to bring them to Moral (amongst much opposition from the enemy of God's children), and through God's grace they are now in Moral and the children are attending school. The parents



are having pastoral help with integrating into the church and the town. Pray for them.



Ana María is a dear sister aged 86 who has been living in Moral for about eight months. She lives with her son Alexander who comes to church with her.

Pray for work for Alexander and for better health for Ana María.

#### SEFOVAN BIBLE TRAINING BY EXTENSION

We thank God that this year we have started a new session. The first class was held on 17 September and the Lord surprised us again by bringing five new students. We thank God for each one, 12 in total. God-willing, seven of them will graduate after this year, adding to the 13 who have already graduated. Let us continue to ask the Lord for men and women who want to be trained to serve Him better in His churches and that they may study with us. Two of our students are not able to pay for their classes, so please pray that the Lord would provide for their studies.

#### HOLIDAY BIBLE CLUB

We were able to resume the Holiday Bible Club this year. We didn't expect many children to attend due to various sporting and play activities taking place on the same days; however, by God's grace about 25 children attended each day and were able to hear the gospel message. Please pray for the seed sown in the hearts of these little ones.





#### VIDAXTREMA 2022 EVANGELISTIC CAMPAIGN

In July we were able to resume preaching the gospel in the town squares of Torrenueva, Castellar de Santiago, Santa Cruz de Mudela, Membrilla, Manzanares, Valdepeñas and Moral. It was such a blessing to be able to share the gospel through preaching, leaflets and all the activities carried out with the sole aim of presenting the gospel as clearly as possible to children and adults who were there. As usually happens when we go to Galicia to visit our family, I am asked to preach in various places or our home church. This summer I was preaching every Sunday on holiday. I know I shouldn't accept preaching requests on holiday, but I find it difficult to say no and I enjoy being with my brothers and sisters and serving them as I am able.

This year my brother Nicolas (who leads the men's group in his church) invited me to hold a miniretreat with them. It was a very special time enjoying my brother's company, but also being able to serve the men who joined us. Sunday evening I preached in church and we were welcomed,



as normal, with much love. It's a privilege to be able to serve God's people.
