Following Jesus's example, we were visiting small towns where there is no evangelical witness at all. Despite the extreme heat in La Mancha and people's hard hearts, we were eagerly continuing to present the only One

who can give salvation: Christ Jesus.

Again, we thank you for supporting us by approaching the Throne of Grace. Here are some items for prayer:

NEW PEOPLE

Due to many people immigrating to Spain at present, especially from Latin American countries, churches are receiving many people who profess faith in the Lord; some are true believers, others just nominal evangelicals. Most come without work and many of them cannot work until they have their necessary documents, causing us to give material help to several families.

Please pray that:

- ✓ As a church, we would know what help to give.
- $\checkmark~$ The Lord would provide the immigrants with work.
- \checkmark Those who are believers would join the church.
- ✓ Those who are not believers would turn to Christ.

EVANGELISTIC WORK

The different discipling groups for both believers and nonbelievers.

How we relate to some unbelieving husbands whose wives are in our congregation.

The Holiday Bible Club for children held the last week of July, when about 30 children and some parents heard the gospel.

The Evangelistic Campaign in various nearby towns.

The special service we held on 21 July when Ruth (daughter of Alwin and Marta) was presented to the Lord. Marta's parents and siblings, who are not believers, attended.

Please pray that:

- ✓ The Lord would give us wisdom to know how to teach His word and apply it to each person's situation.
- $\checkmark~$ The Lord would give fruit from teaching and preaching His word.
- ✓ The Lord would touch the hearts of Spanish people.

PASTORAL WORK

Visits to church families.

- $\checkmark~$ The joy of the Lord would fill their hearts with the great hope they have in Christ.
- \checkmark Vicente would recover some strength in his legs.
- $\checkmark~$ Both would be a living testimony for Christ to the other residents.
